



Abu Simbel Add-On

Join our trip to Abu Simbel from Aswan by air to visit these two rock-carved temples that are unique both in style and in their setting on the banks of Lake Nasser.

Our representative will pick you up from your Nile Cruise in Aswan to transfer to Aswan Airport for your flight to Abu Simbel.

The temples of Abu Simbel are amongst the most interesting Pharaonic temples. Located close to the southern border with Sudan it is 280 klms/174 miles south of Aswan and consists of two temples dating back to the reign of King Ramses II (1290 -1223 BC) These temples, with their unique style, are considered to be the masterpieces of ancient Egypt. They reflect the glory and grandeur of the new Kingdom.

The Egyptian government and UNESCO decided to co-operate in order to save these temples from flooding. The Temple of Ramses II was dedicated to the four universal gods Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and to Ramses II himself.

The great Abu Simbel temple is also called The Sun Temple of Ramses II. The Temple of Queen Nefertari is also Called Temple of Hathor who was the wife of the Sun God so in a symbolic way, the two Temples, that of Ramses II and that of Nefertari, bring Ramses II, Nefertari, Hathor and the Sun God together as one.

After your visit you will be escorted back from Abu Simbel to Aswan.
